Tanha is a Teaching Fellow in the MA in Education program at AUW. Alongside her teaching role, she conducts AUW's institutional research and manages the alumnae database. Before earning her master's from Central European University she worked at the BRAC Institute of Educational Development, promoting early childhood education and play-based learning. Tanha also serves as Project Manager for the UNICEF-funded Upper Primary Teachers Training Program in the Rohingya Refugee Camps, overseeing the training of over 1000 educators in this humanitarian setting.
