

## Short C.V. of Professor Shams Rahman PhD

Dr Shams Rahman is a Professor at the Department of Business Administration, East West University (EWU), Dhaka Bangladesh who in 2021 and 2022 has been recognized among the world's top 2% of scholars. Prior to joining EWU he worked at the University of Sydney, the University of Western Australia, and RMIT University. He is a former British Commonwealth scholar who held visiting fellowships at several universities including MIT (Zaragoza Logistics Center), Virginia Tech, and the University of Exeter.

Professor Rahman is an Associate Editor of the International Journal of Information Systems and Supply Chain Management and sits on the editorial board of fifteen international journals. He has published over 250 research papers and served as a Guest Editor for several top-ranked journals. In addition, he has widely published for practitioners in the industry and trade journals. Professor Rahman has advised multinational companies and consulting firms on lean manufacturing, remanufacturing, sustainability, food cold chain, and talent management and successfully led several externally funded projects. He is dedicated to interdisciplinary research and education, and integrated approaches to defining and unravelling supply chain challenges and societal concerns. Professor Rahman's current research interest is in supply chain sustainability, disruptive technology, and talent management.
