**Touhida Tasnima, PhD**

Dr Touhida Tasnima is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Social Relations, East West University (EWU). She has been involved with university teaching for 18 years. Aside from teaching at East West University, she also worked as a part-time Lecturer in Gender Studies program at the University of Malaya, Malaysia. She received her first MSS degree in Public Administration from the University of Dhaka and obtained her second master's degree in Development Studies from the International Institute of Social Studies, Erasmus University, The Hague, Netherlands. Her research at the master's program was focused on neo liberal policy, the dominant socio-economic paradigm in Bangladesh and how it created an impact on the quality assurance of private higher education institutions in the country. Dr Tasnima has completed her Doctorate from the University of Malaya and her PhD research represents a dialectic of gender oppression and digitally enabled routes to liberation for women's empowerment to address violence. She is a reviewer of the *Journal of Women's Studies International Forum*, Science Direct and *Malaysian Journal of Media Studies*, University of Malaya. Situated firmly within development studies and informed by gender dimensions and technological advancement, her work focuses on the tensions between equity, sustainability and emancipatory socio-economic change. Her recent publications broadly lie in the field of gender, technology and sustainable development issues in the developing country context.
